

Negro Bound Over On Murder Charge

Probable Cause Found Against Jimmie Lee Holmes

Given a preliminary hearing in Recorder's Court Wednesday of last week, probable cause was found against Jimmie Lee Holmes, 45-year-old Negro who is charged with murdering his wife of less than two months, Viola Rankin Holmes. The

woman was shot to death at the couple's home on North Granville Street. He will be tried in Chowan Superior Court.

Holmes is also charged with assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill, due to serious injuries inflicted on Celia Mebane, 27-year-old Negro woman, who was at the scene at the time of the shooting. The Mebane woman was shot in the hip when she attempted to leave the Holmes house. Holmes fled after the crime and was picked up in Baxley, Ga., from where he was brought back to face the charges.
