Objectives Are Listed For Handicap Week

Mrs. Corie B. White, manager of mrs. Corre B. write, manager of the Edenton Employment Security Commission, releases the following missions and objectives in connection with National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week which is being ob-served this week.

1. Develop and improve community and State NEPH organizations so that a dynamic year-round program of public information and education is initiated and carried out.

2. Direct local NEPH programs toward employers with jobs to offer, including small employers who may not have been asked to cooperate before.

3. Encourage all employers to hire qualified handicapped workers, including those with severe disabilities.

4. Encourage physically handicapped individuals to apply for necessary rehabilitation services from their State Vocational Rehabilitation agency or the Veterans' Administration.

5. Improve and expand counseling and selective placement services for the handicapped in the public employment offices.

6. Encourage greater community support of private and public agencies providing services for preparation and placement of handicapped workers.

In addition to the general objectives the following special objectives are specific enough to light the way for individuals and groups wishing to co. operate in this program of promoting greater employment opportunities for the physically handicapped.

7. Encourage physicians to use preemployment physical examinations as a means of matching or restoring the worker's abilities to the job's requirements, not as a search for defects a good man that can qualify as head leading to thoughtless rejection of the salesman and assistant manager. application.

8. Encourage union officials to become more familiar with the capabilities of the handicapped and to participate more actively in plant programs for their employment.

9. Encourage physicians and welfare workers to recommend early physical and vocational rehabilitation character and be able to furnish good services leading to reemployment of references. This is a good opportunity injured workers.

10. Encourage the inclusion of the story of handicapped workers in secondary, under-graduate and post-graduate courses at schools and col-

11. Encourage community survey projects aimed at locating handicapped men and women who can be employed or prepared for jobs.

12. Provide for forums, institutes, seminars and expositions for explaining the "know how" of selective placement to management and labor officials.

13. Encourage cooperation of all community agencies and organizations in providing the services necessary for Korean war disabled and other handicapped veterans to make a satisfactory adjustment to civilian life.

14. Last but not least, encourage employers to list jobs for handicapped workers with the nearest State Employment Service local office, and encourage the handicapped to register for jobs there.
