Peach Shortcake

Turn on oven and set at hot (425). Mix in a quart bowl the biscuit mix and sugar. Stir in with fork a mixture of milk and water. Turn out on lightly floured board. Knead lightly 10 times, or until smooth. Roll ½ inch thick. Cut into 4 rounds with floured 3-inch cutter. Bake on ungreased baking sheet 10 minutes, or until brown. At serving time, put ice-cold milk and 4 teaspoons sugar into small, cold bowl. Whip with cold beater until fluffy. Add lemon rind and juice. Whip until stiff. Break open the shortcakes and put together with the peaches. Serve with whipped topping. Makes 4 servings.
