ington chair, old records since the lodge was organized in 1775 and other historical relics could be displayed. He also informed the Commissioners that the trustees had heard that it was contemplated to transform the room into a chamber for judges who preside over Superior Court sessions, where they could rest or meet for conferences.

The trustees made it clear that they were not especially requesting the room after the lodge moves into its new temple, but rather to notify the Commissioners that it will be vacated, so that the Commissioners can decide what disposition they desire to make of it.

Chairman W. W. Byrum said he had heard some suggestions that the room be retained by the Masons to use as a museum and further that it should be used as a judge's chamber or a place to store county records. As to the latter, he stated the county is badly in need of storage space for various kinds of records.

No action was taken Monday, but Mr. Byrum urged the other Commissioners to be thinking seriously about what they think would be the best possible use to be made of the small room when the Masons move to their new quarters.

Mr. Byrum complimented the Masons for their attractive building which is gradually being completed principally by members of the fraternity.


TAX COLLECTIONS
