

A lawn should be fertilized every five to six weeks throughout the growing season. If you haven't already done so, put on an application of a good garden fertilizer such as a 6-8-6 at the rate of 20 pounds per 1,000 square feet. Water this in or apply it just before a rain. For the remainder of the season use about five pounds of nitrate of soda per 1,000 square feet at each application. This should be applied when the grass is

dry and preferably just before a rain. Watering is a very important operation. Soak the soil thoroughly at least once a week during dry weather rather than light sprinklings each day, although these light sprinklings do

Frequent cutting is desirable, but lose cutting will do much harm to some of the better grasses such as bluegrass. Set the mower blades a little higher for these grasses.
