

U. S. Army Hires Jap Girls As Auto Drivers

Yokohama—Military police on duty at the entrance to the Camp McGill Sub-Depot of Camp Yokohama no longer do a doubletake when an Army jeep, jockeyed by a gal in civilian clothes, rolls by.

Instead, they check the trip-ticket, exchange pleasantries and wave her on her way. She happens to be one of three Japanese females employed by the Army in the Camp McGill Transportation Section.

The girls, efficiently performing such duties as chauffeuring military personnel and delivering courier messages, are among 394 Japanese nationals working at the transportation section, located near Yokosuka, site of the U. S. Security Force's largest naval base in the East. The section is supervised by a staff of 12 U. S. Army Transportation Corps personnel.

All Japanese drivers are required to pass the Army's standard schooling in preventive maintenance. In addition, the drivers must learn to prepare accident reports and pass tests pertaining to military vehicle operation. Physical aptitude and proficiency tests taken every six months, round out the driver program.

Each of the motor pool's fleet of vehicles, ranging from jeeps to trailer-vans, has a detailed "personal history" file to record its maintenance. Mechanical repairs of major proportions are performed by skilled Japanese mechanics at the camp's maintenance shops.

The Japanese-operated motor pool enables the Army Transportation Corps personnel to be assigned in other areas.

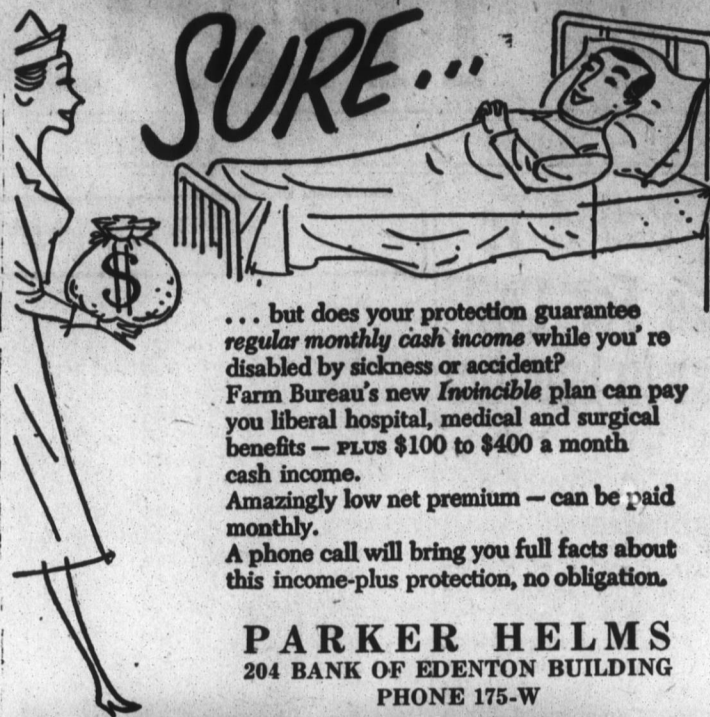

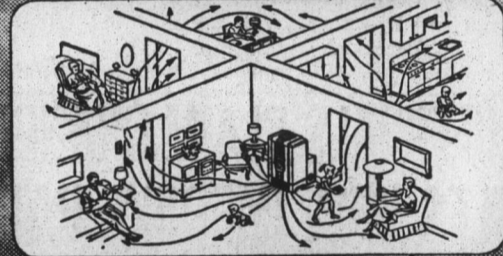
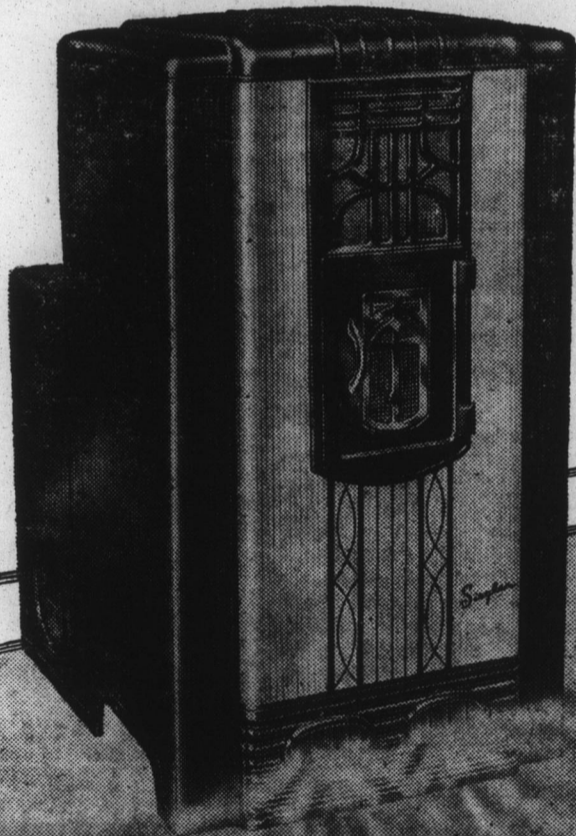
