

Testing Milk Cows Is About Completed

Dr. Bradshaw Plans to Return to County at Later Date

In cooperation with Dr. Bradshaw, Federal veterinarian, the testing of milk cows in Chowan County was about completed last week with the exception of those in several beef herds. Several small herds of beef cattle have been tested also. Other beef herds will be tested within the next two or three months as Dr. Bradshaw desires.

The rush of peanut picking and harvesting of other farm crops at this time makes it very inconvenient for beef cattle owners to get up their herds and make necessary preparation for testing the cattle. Dr. Bradshaw will return at a later period when the rush harvest season is over. Chowan cattle owners have given excellent cooperation in having their cattle penned up as notified.

Cranberry Delight

1/2 cup Pet evaporated Milk
10 marshmallows
1 lb. can whole cranberry sauce, crushed

9 oz. can crushed pineapple, drained
2 Tablespoon lemon juice
1/2 teaspoon salt

Put milk into ice cube tray of refrigerator. Chill until ice crystals begin to form around the edges. Dice marshmallows into a 2-qt. bowl. Mix in rest of ingredients. Put ice cold milk into cold 1-qt. bowl. Whip with cold rotary beater by hand, or with electric beater at high speed, until fluffy. Fold into marshmallow mixture. Put into serving dishes and chill until ready to serve. Makes 4 generous servings, or average servings for 2 meals.
