Community speakers to the group were Mrs. Blanchard and Chaplain Veltman. The bulletin board group was headed by Nevada Collins. James Hodgeboth was chairman of the original play group and James Blount was chairman of cartoon displays.

Each member of the class submitted editorials, feature stories and news stories. Grades four through twelve were shown a series of films on the prevention and control of tuberculosis at the school gymnasium. The Language Arts Class was aided by the local tuberculosis association and a number of citizens in the community in carrying out the project on the prevention and control of tuberculosis.

P & Q Super Market's **RECIPE OF THE WEEK** By Mary Lee Taylor **Braised Veal Cutlets**

2 Tablespoons flour 2 Tablespoons hot fat
1 teaspoon dry mustard 1/2 cup finely cut onion
1/2 teaspoon ground ginger 1 1/2 cups boiling water
1 1/2 teaspoons salt 1/4 teaspoon pepper 2 1/2 cup Per Evaporated Milk

Mix together on piece of paper the flour, mustard, ginger, salt and pepper. With saucer, pound flour mixture into both sides of cutlets. Brown cutlets on both sides in hot fat in skillet. Push meat to one side of skillet. Add onion and cook slowly until light brown. Then add boiling water. Cover and cook over low heat about 1 hour, or until meat is tender. Remove meat to warm platter. Stir milk into liquid left in skillet. Stir over low heat until steaming hot and slightly thickened, but do not boil. Serve hot with the meat. Makes 4 servings.
