A. B. Hart, County Director, announced today that total sales of U. S. Savings Bonds in Chowan County for the period of October 1, 1951, totaled \$8,350. Total county sales for the period of January 1, 1951, to October 31, 1951, totaled \$149,198.

A monthly report by North Carolina State Director, Walter W. H. Anderson, State Chairman of Savings Bonds, advised that sales for the entire year to date are \$1,612,500. Total county sales for the period of January 1, 1951, to October 31, 1951, totaled \$149,198, an increase of 48 percent over the same period of a year ago.

The monthly report also states that sales for the year to date are as for North Carolina to set a new record.

State Asked Maintain Old Bear Swamp Road

Chowan County Commissioners have presented a petition at their meeting Monday morning requesting the State Highway & Public Works Commission to improve and maintain a road in Chowan and Perquimans counties.

The road is in the Second Township running from the Hartford-Center Hill highway to the Bear Swamp road near Nixen Holloway's farm. It is known as the old Bear Swamp road and extends 1 1/2 miles in Chowan County and one mile in Perquimans.

The petition was signed by nine property owners and a similar request was presented to the Perquimans County Commissioners Monday.

The Chowan Commissioners approved the request and sent it to the Highway Commission for consideration.
