

## "This Is Your Army" Movie To Be Shown Throughout United States

WASHINGTON—The U. S. Army's readiness for immediate retaliation against possible communist aggression anywhere in the world is illustrated dramatically in the new color documentary motion picture, "This Is Your Army."

This unusual film, produced by Movietone News for the Army, is being released (in December, 1954) to theaters throughout the United States. It presents a comprehensive report on the Army—its soldiers, its leaders, its weapons—to the people of the United States and shows American taxpayers the military muscles their dollars are buying.

Movietone News cameramen visited more than 60 military installations in the United States and ten other countries to shoot film for the exciting 55-minute picture, which is being distributed as a public service on a non-profit basis by the Council of Motion Picture Organizations, Inc.

The film originally was produced as a troop information movie and already has been seen by hundreds of thousands of soldiers.

"This Is Your Army" will be of equal interest to young men and women who expect to serve in the Army, to the parents of men and women now in the Army, and to veterans of World War I and II and Korea who will find a powerful fighting force greatly different to that in which they served.

The Army's mighty new family of tanks and awesome new weapons—atomic cannon, supersonic guided missiles, and bombardment rockets—are shown in breathtaking action.

But even in the era of push button wonder weapons, importance of the individual soldier is revealed simply and effectively. "This Is Your Army" brings home the fact that nuclear warfare would call for more, not fewer, soldiers with far more technical training than ever before required.

Problems encountered in producing the color film were monumental when compared to usual motion picture operations. Getting the full Army story on film involved efforts of thousands of Army personnel at installations around the world and required cooperation of many foreign governments. Few, if any, motion pictures ever made before required participation of so many people.

Camera crews labored in the

snows of Alaska and the jungles of Panama, photographed U. S. soldiers in training in Japan and Germany, filmed reports of activities of our allies in Turkey, Greece and Italy; obtained detailed accounts of the activities of U. S. soldiers and Republic of Korea troops on the alert against renewed red aggression in Korea.

In one breath-taking scene, filmed in Formosa, 90,000 Chinese soldiers are shown marching toward the camera and cheering Generalissimo Chiang Kai-Shek. The U. S. Army's mission in helping to train these Nationalist forces is shown in detail.

State of readiness of the Army in Berlin, an island of freedom in a sea of communism, is shown in a grand review of U. S. troops.

"This Is Your Army" opens with a prologue which outlines the worldwide responsibilities of the United States and the Army's mission. It shows induction of soldiers at a reception center, covers their basic training under realistic battle conditions, and goes on to field maneuvers and the training of soldiers who man highly technical weapons of heretofore unequalled killing power. Top level Army commanders, both at the Pentagon Building in Washington and in the field, are shown at work.

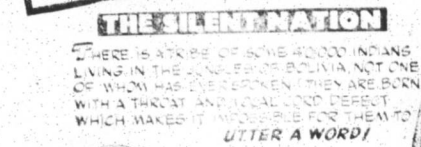
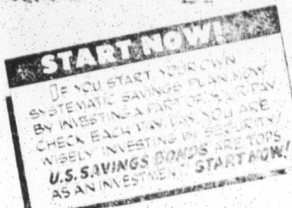

### Kitchen Comment

To speed the drying and shaping of sweaters, place them on a turkish towel and press out the excess moisture with a rolling pin.

When washing crocheted or knitted spreads, stretch to proper size and shape while wet and hang over parallel lines.

A quick 5-minute fudge frosting for the top of an eight or nine inch square cake can be made this way: In a saucepan melt 1 tablespoon margarine in 2 tablespoons milk. Stir in 1/2 cup sifted powdered sugar, 1/4 cup cocoa, and 1/4 teaspoon salt; cook about 1 minute. Remove from heat; add 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract and 1/4 cup coarsely chopped nuts. Beat until thickened.

When carpets and rugs are cleaned often and thoroughly, dust and dirt are removed before any serious harm can be done by them.

A Pennsylvania homemaker recommends this method for removing lipstick stains from cotton fabrics: Work glycerine into the fabric and then wash in the usual way.

### RECORD EGG PRODUCTION

Laying flocks in the Tar Heel State produced an estimated 102 million eggs during November—the highest production of record for that month, being 12 per cent above the previous record of 91

million in 1953.

The North Carolina Crop Reporting Service reports there were 8,944,000 layers on hand during November compared to 8,972,000 a year earlier. The rate of lay during November, 1954, of 1,140 eggs per 100 layers was 12 per cent above the rate for November, 1953, of 1,014 eggs per 100 layers.

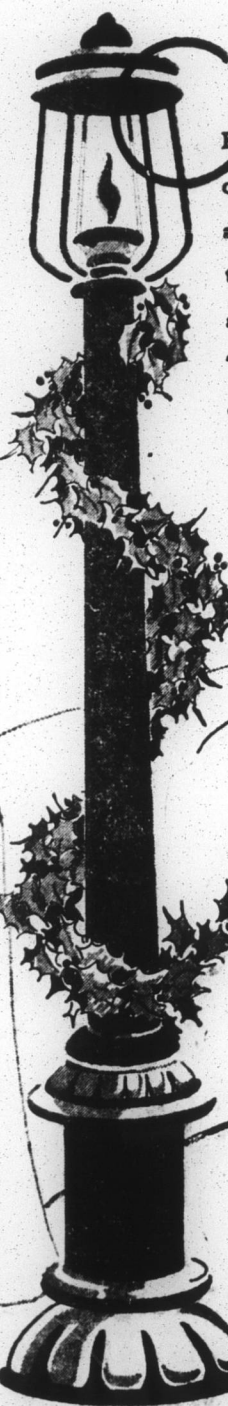

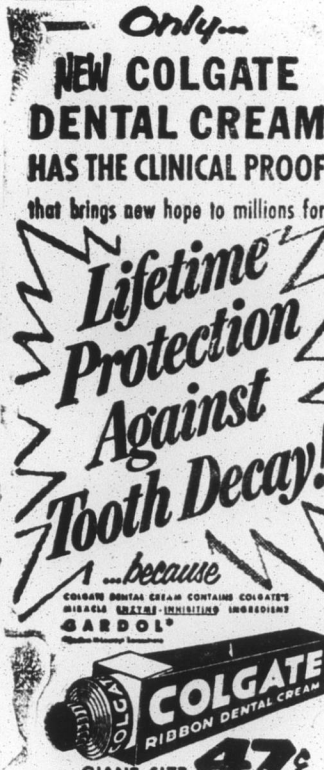
