Weekly Devotional Column

Last week I discussed what it means to be filled with the Holy Spirit, and just how the individual Saint may receive that filling. Today I would like to consider with you the signs, or evidences of a Spirit-filled life.

First of all, I don't believe there is anything in Scripture to justify the view that speaking in tongues is the initial evidence of being filled with the Holy Spirit. I would not venture to criticize the modern tongues movement, for the Bible plainly states "Forbid not to speak in tongues," and those who are identified with the movement are without dispute godly, Christian people. But it is possible for a person to be filled with the Holy Spirit without speaking in tongues. Indeed, I Corinthians 12:10, and 12:30 seem to indicate that the gift of tongues is definitely not for all Spirit-filled Christians.

There are, however, definite indications that a person has been filled with the Holy Spirit. The first of these is the fruit of the Spirit in his life. "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance" (Galatians 5:22-23). The presence of those qualities in a person's life is a good indication he is a Spirit-filled Christian.

Another indication of a Spirit-filled life is power: Power in witnessing (Acts 1:8) and power in prayer (Ephesians 6:18).

The person who is Spirit-filled will have a deep love for the Lord Jesus, for it is the office of the Holy Spirit to increase our love for the Saviour. The Spirit-filled Christian will also have a deep love for others, for "The love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the

Holy Ghost which is given unto us" (Romans 5:5).

The Spirit-filled Christian loves the Bible, and understands it as he reads it, for the Holy Spirit is the Author of the Bible, and He alone is able to open its pages to us.

The Spirit-filled Saint is deeply sensitive to sin, for it is the Holy Spirit who convicts us of sin, who causes us to see it as God sees it, and hate it. The Spirit-filled Christian will speak the Word of God boldly, without fear or compromise (Acts 4:31).

Is it God's will that each Christian be filled with the Holy Spirit? Not only is it His will, but He commands us, "Be filled with the Spirit" (Ephesians 5:18). It is disobedience to a direct command of Scripture for a Christian not to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Further, so important is this filling that Jesus actually forbade His disciples to do any Christian work until they had received it (Luke 24:49). If you are not filled with the Holy Spirit, and display in your life the evidences listed above, you have no business teaching Sunday School, singing in the choir, or doing anything else for the Lord.

Would you be filled with the Spirit? Then examine yourself; and cast out from your life anything and everything that is not according to the direct will of God. Dedicate your life, your talents, your wealth, your reputation, everything you have and everything you are to God's control. Ask Him to fill you with His Spirit, and trust Him for that filling. Jesus, fill now with Thy Spirit. Hearts that full-surrender know, That the streams of living water From the inner man may flow.

Offices Of County Agents Will Close All Day Saturdays

Agents Will Open Offices at 8 A. M. Instead of 8:30

Offices of the white County and Home Agents of Chowan County will be closed Saturdays beginning next Saturday, May 7, according to County Agent C. W. Overman. This is in accordance with a res-

olution passed by the Chowan County Commissioners at their regular meeting on May 2. These offices will be open at 8 o'clock each week day.

Mr. Overman's office has kept a record of the farmers calling at the office on Saturday morning for the last three weeks. An average of two farmers had called for Extension information. Since the SCS and ACP offices are closed on Saturdays, any farmers calling for information from them cannot be served by the Extension office because they are not in position to perform their duties. By opening the offices at 8 o'clock each morning, as the other agricultural offices do, it is felt that the agents will be in a better position to serve

farmers during that extra thirty minutes each day than by remaining open on Saturday. If this change works any necessary hardship, on farmers Mr. Overman wants to know.

117 Receive Old Age Assistance In April

During the month of April 117 persons in Chowan County received \$2,976 in way of old age assistance payments. Eleven aid to dependent children received \$411, while 12 aid to blind cases received \$438 and 13 aid to permanently and totally disabled received \$497.

During the month general assistance in the amount of \$29,09 was given to four people and other fi-

nancial assistance included \$376.50 for seven cases hospitalized in the county and \$48.50 for three cases hospitalized outside the county.

Service cases included one person receiving free eye examination through the N. C. State Commission for the Blind, one investigation made for the Chowan County Draft Board, seven child labor cer-

tificates issued and nine children received individual service.

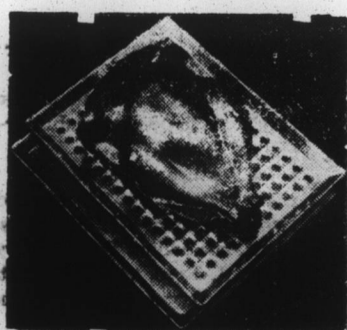
