# Marsh is Chosen As **Talent For Service Chairman In County**

#### State College Scholarships Available to **Students**

Application materials for scholarships at North Carolina State College during the next academic year are being distributed this week for the use of high school seniors throughout the State.

In reporting this, Dr. Ralph Fadum, chairman of the college's Scholarship and Student Aid Committee, and Dr. Lyle B. Rogers, student financial aid officer at the institution, also announced the list of county chairmen who will be in charge of screening scholarship applicants from their counties.

Robert S. Marsh has been named "Talent For Service" chairman for Chowan County.

Under the program, 25 to 30 awards, known as "Talent for Service" scholarships, are made each year to outstanding high school students who are interested in the fields of study provided at State College.

The scholarships average \$2,000 in total value, usually amounting to \$500 per year for a four-year period. All applicants are censid ered not only for the "Talent for Service" scholarships but for various other awards.

The "Talent for Service" Committee in each county helps to distribute application materials to the various schools, accepts and screens the recommended applicants from cach school, and forwards them to the college for final processing More than 600 applicants were handled in this way during the 1955-56 school year and nearly 200 awards of one kind or another were made to entering students.
