College Graduates Being Accepted In **Officers'** Courses

The Marine Corps will accept to 700 college graduates for its first two 1958 Officer Candidate Courses, according to Captain W C. Holmberg, Marine Corps Officer Procurement Officer for this

Also eligible for the courses are college seniors who will graduate at mid-term.

The Officer Candidate Course provides an important segment of all new officers entering the Marine Corps each year. It is held periodically at the Marine Corps Schools, Quantico, Va., and lasts 10 weeks. A second lieutenant's commission in the Marine Corps Reserve follows the successful completion of this training.

Capt. Holmberg said the 21st Officer Candidate Course will begin January 13, 1958, and have a anned enrollment of 510. The 22nd OCC, with 190 enrollments, is scheduled to start the following March 31.

Upon commissioning at the completion of OCC training, the new officers are assigned to Basie School at Quantico.




