

Civil Defense

Test May 6-7

The extent of North Carolina's readiness to cope with direct nuclear attack will be put to a crucial test May 6-7 during "Operation Alert 1958", the fifth annual Civil Defense nation-wide exercise.

State Civil Defense forces are getting set for an extensive simulated attack which is expected to include more numerous strikes upon North Carolina "target" areas than any previous exercise, and which will throw the state and its counties and towns entirely dependent on their own resources for the duration of the attack period.

State Civil Defense Director, Edward F. Griffin, has notified all local Civil Defense authorities from Manteo to Murphy of the importance of their taking part in the exercise. Heads of all departments of state government and Civil Defense liaison officers from other agencies have also been urged to participate.

"Purpose of the briefing," Griffin says, "is to point out the problems which will be encountered in an exercise of the type expected or an actual emergency, and simplify their plans to participate."

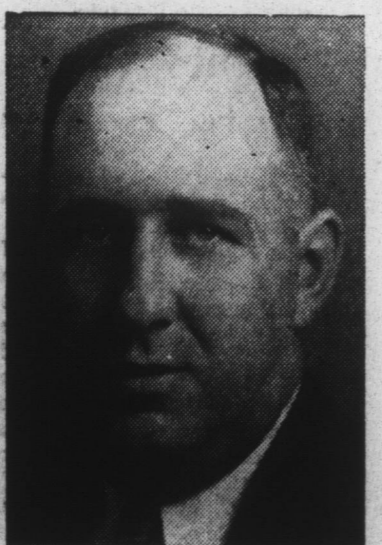
