

### SOIL CONSERVATION NEWS

Last Thursday night (August 28) I attended a meeting of landowners in Folly Ditch Watershed in Gates County. These people made application in April, 1957 for Federal assistance in developing their watershed under Public Law 566 or the Small Watershed Act. Their application was approved for planning. In June, 1958, the watershed plan was completed and presented to the landowners last Thursday night.

In the watershed plan were 7.4 miles of channel plus land treatment measures such as pasture, sod waterways, tree planting, cover crops, drainage for individual farms and terraces. Land treatment measures will be installed on individual farms using financial assistance such as the A.G.P. program. The 7.4 miles of channel

construction will be financed by local landowners and the small watershed program (P.L.566).

In the plan presented by Lonnie Thompson, SCS engineer, the Federal government will pay 66 2/3 per cent of the cost of 7.4 miles of channel and landowners will furnish 33 1/2 per cent. Estimated cost of right-of-ways, clearing, and digging the channel was \$24,831. Federal funds offered for the project were \$14,847, leaving \$9,984 for landowners. Landowners accepted this offer with only one person against it.

The Folly Ditch Watershed is 3,000 acres in size. Total cost of improvements is \$49,612 including the drainage and land treatment. For drainage, the cost per acre is \$3. This is the farmers' share of the channel construction.

Chowan County landowners can use P.L. 566 to get our main streams cleaned out. It will help us to develop our natural resources. There are several places in the county where an adequate outlet for drainage cannot be obtained now. All of our streams are choked with silt, logs, trees and debris and after a rain the streams are muddy and overflowing. You, the landowner, can do something about it. What are you going to do about it? This small watershed act (P.L. 566) provides assistance to local organizations only. It is not a Federal project with local assistance... it is a local project with Federal assistance. This means that local people must start the project and then ask for Federal help. Assistance to any group is available at the local SCS office in the

basement of the Post Office or through your supervisors of the local Soil Conservation District. Local district supervisors are L. C. Bunch, J. A. Webb, Jr., and R. H. Hollowell.

A county meeting is planned in about two weeks to explain P.L. 566 and letters of invitation will be mailed to all landowners. The meeting will be at the Court House in Edenton on or about September 12 at 7:30 P. M. More news about that later. Make plans to attend this meeting if you are interested in getting your main streams developed. Examples of possible projects in the county are Pembroke-Pollock Swamp, Rocky Hook Creek, Queen Anne Creek, Dillard Swamp, Sandy Run Creek, Middleton Creek, Stumpy Creek, Warwick Swamp, Burnt Mill Creek and others. These creeks may be combined or in almost any type of organization desired by the local people.

Come to the meeting and bring your neighbor and find out what
