Cotton Estimated At 285,000 Bales

Cotton production in North Carolina is estimated at 285,000 bales of 500 pounds gross weight by the North Carolina Crop Re-, porting Service. The Septemher 1 forecast is 10,000 bales above the August 1 estimate and compares with 232,000 bales prouced last year and the 10-year (1960-59) average production of 362.000 bales.

If the September 1 forecast materializes, a crop of this size would be 53,000 bales or 22.8 rcent above 1960 production but 21.3 percent below the 10year average production.


