

Memorial Funds Being Sought In Chowan To Combat Cancer

In response to numerous requests from families, other groups and individuals, the American Cancer Society has inaugurated a memorial fund to which families and friends of cancer victims may contribute, according to Mrs. Warren Twiddy, chairman of the 1962 Chowan County Cancer Crusade.

"The memorial fund has been established to provide a practical and fitting means by which families or friends can commemorate a loved one who has died of cancer or other cause," Mrs. Twiddy said.

Contributions made in memory of a family member or a friend are acknowledged by the American Cancer Society and a memorial card is sent to the family, other group or individual stating that a memorial has been received and giving the name of the donor. These contributions may be in any amount and are tax deductible.

Memorial funds are used in support of the society's unceasing fight against cancer through

coordinating programs of research, education and service. Mrs. Twiddy points out also that although the major source of funds for these programs comes from the society's annual April Crusade, memorial gifts received throughout the year are becoming increasingly important as more families and individuals become aware that they can contribute in the name of a loved one toward ultimate victory over the dread disease of cancer.

"Memorial funds should be sent to the Chowan County Cancer Unit of the American Cancer Society," says Mrs. Twiddy, "in order that Crowan County benefit from this fund. As Crusade Chairman I will be glad to accept these gifts or they may be made to Mrs. W. J. P. Earnhardt, executive secretary of Chowan County Unit."

The Memorial Program is conducted year-around with special emphasis on holidays and seasons, such as Mother's Day, Thanksgiving, Memorial Day and Christmas.

Herbert S. Small is seeking the office

In the Second Township Tom Asbell is a candidate for County Commissioner. He will oppose Carey Evans of Rocky Hook who succeeded J. R. Peele when the latter declined to be a candidate in the last election. Carey Hollowell, who is seeking re-election as Commissioner from the Third Township, will also face opposition. Lester T. Copeland of Tyner will oppose him for the office.

A unique contest has developed in the Fourth Township for County Commissioner. Mrs. James L. Hassell will be a candidate, opposing Dallas Jethro, Jr., incumbent, who is seeking re-election. Mrs. Hassell, daughter of former Mayor Jasper L. Wiggins, is the first woman to run in an election for County Commissioner.

A contest has also developed for the Chowan County Board of Education. These members are now elected by the voters. N. J. George, manager of George Chevrolet Company and a former school teacher will be a

candidate. With the six present members seeking re-election, Mr. George makes seven candidates seeking the six seats on the board. Present members are G. B. Potter, chairman, O. C. Long, Marvin Evans, Garland Asbell, Eugene Jordan and John M. Elliott. The latter is filling the unexpired term of Dr. L. F. Ferguson, who retired when he moved to Florida.

Candidates who will have no opposition are Sheriff Earl Goodwin; J. Clarence Leary, County Commissioner; W. S. Privott, judge of Recorder's Court and John Shackelford, prosecuting attorney of Recorder's Court.

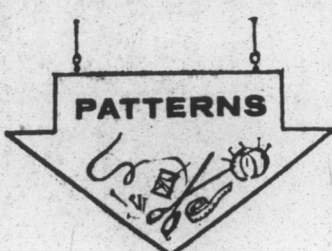

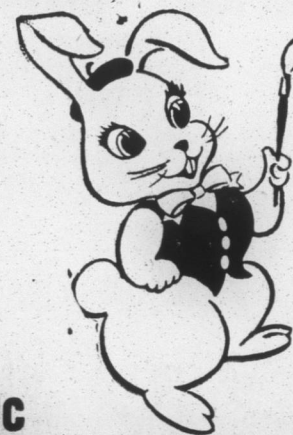
