**Adapt and Adopt "Milk" As Beverage**—The American Dairy Association's theme for summer is "Keep milk on your table. It's the Pitcher of Health." Let's adapt and adopt for our family's health with this nutritious beverage.

**Pickin' Peaches**—Let your eye be your guide—the best thing to remember in picking quality peaches is that they must look to go good. Size and color should play an extremely important part in your choice. Make sure they are plump, smooth skinned, and well filled out. The color on the underside of a peach should be creamy white or yellow, blushed with red. Over-ripeness is generally indicated by the deeper reddish brown color and a softness of the fruit. Peaches in this stage are suitable for immediate use, but cannot be held for any length of time.

Peaches are a rather low cal-

orie fruit—another reason why it makes a fine in-between meal snack that won't add extra pounds to anyone's figure and yet will satisfy hunger.

**The Peach Picture**  
Me! Kóbe, Extension Horticulturist, reports: excellent quality Sandhill peaches are rolling to market. Right now Coronets, Sunhigh (freestones) Dixiegems, Red Havens, Jersey Lands—sometimes called Beauty Gems—(semi-cling) are available. These are yellow fleshed varieties, look for Triogems, Keystone, and Washington soon, along with Hale Haven and Golden Jubilee. These are all processing varieties and now is the time to use them while volume is high, quality tops, and prices attractive.

**Good Weather Producing Good Vegetables**—Locally grown vegetables are coming to market. Prices continue to move downward with increased production. Snapbeans, cabbage, butterbeans, white and yellow squash, green peppers, corn and cucumbers are excellent quality vegetables

for summertime eating pleasure. Celery is on the short side, due to Florida season ending and California's crop being down in supply. Lettuce is of good quality and price. Tomatoes are moving in good volume and harvesting heavy in nearby southern states. Indications are for a good supply during July for North Carolina tomatoes.

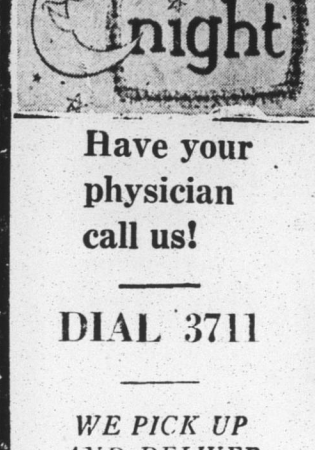

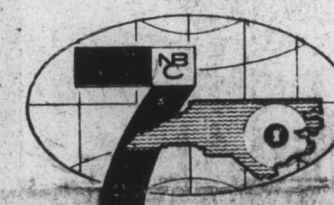

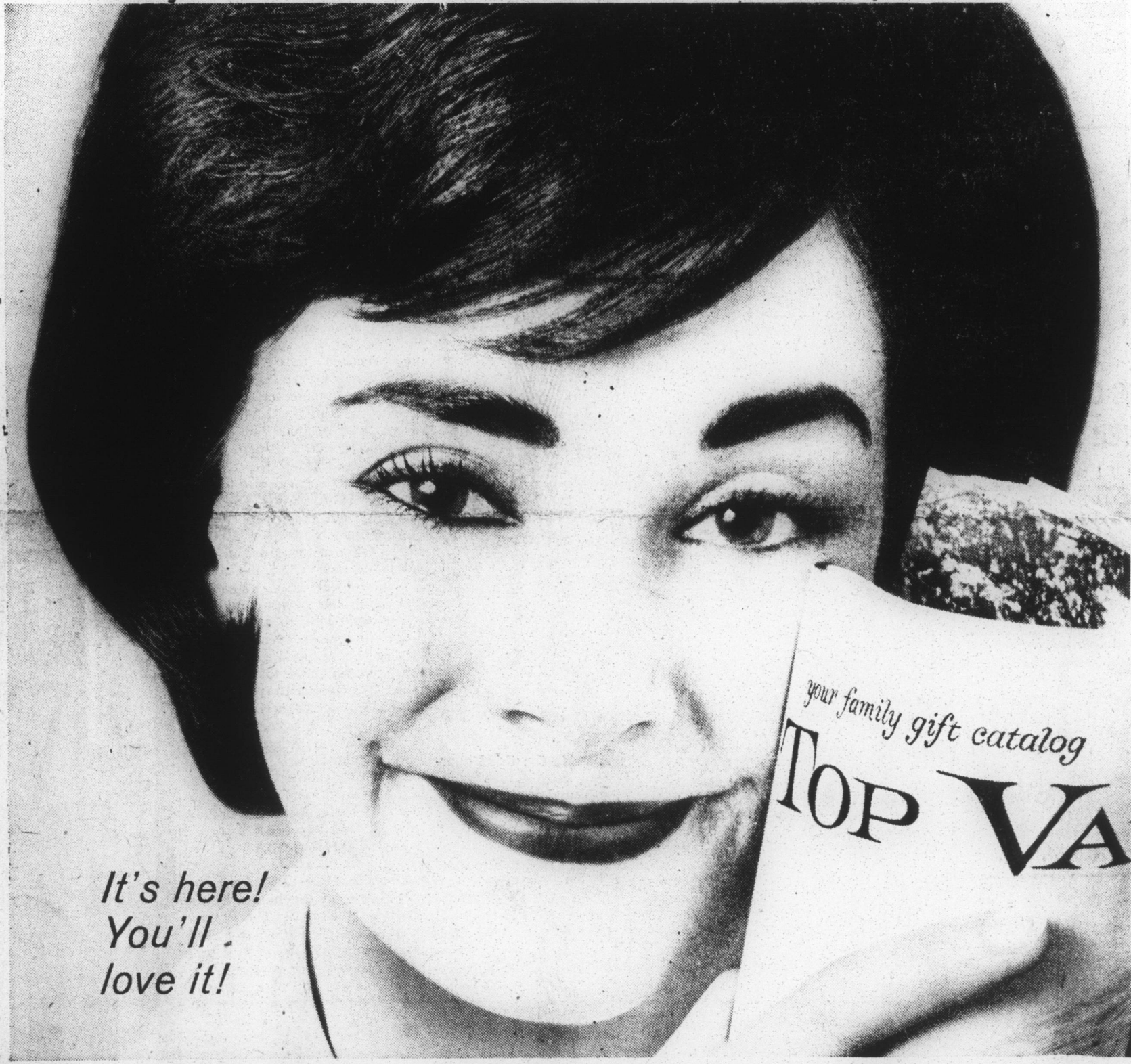
