**HARVEST HOME DAY AT KADESH CHURCH SUNDAY**

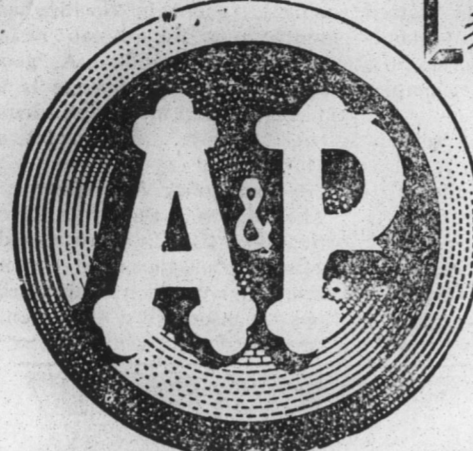
Harvest Home Day will be observed at Kadesh A. M. E. Zion Church Sunday, October 28.

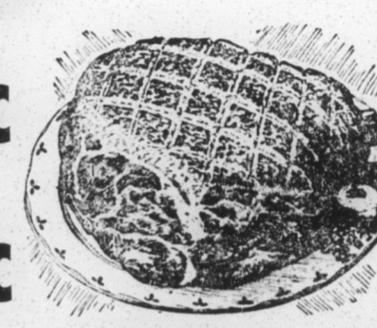
