17, the Ocean Highway. Edenton will benefit greatly from this additional tourist business."

For the first time, a physical connection now exists between the Virginia, mainland and the Eastern Shore. It was made Wednesday with the driving into the bay bottom of the final pile for this tremendous project.

The 126-foot concrete pile was the 2,640th driven to support the 12.2 miles of concrete roadway -about two-thirds the total length of the world's longest bridge-tunnel, Byrum said. Plac ing of the roadway deck will be finished by the end of September, it was stated.

No celebration is planned, said Byrum, although the event will end a 2-month task that started at the south edge of Chesapeake Bay, March 28, 1961. The real celebration, of course, will be in March next year when the first of the traveling public's vehicles will begin crossing the complet-


