

Limited Service For Mail Will Go In Effect May 4

Adjustments Will Not Have Any Effect on Home and Special Delivery

The limited adjustments in some postal services ordered in Washington March 10 by Postmaster General John A. Gronouski to save \$12.7 million will begin to take effect in Edenton and other cities May 4, Postmaster J. L. Chestnut says.

Service changes planned locally include the following, Mr. Chestnut said:

1—Parcel Post Deliveries: Parcel Post delivery service will be provided on a five-day week basis, except that six-day service shall be continued on all rural routes. There will be no parcel post deliveries in Edenton on Wednesday. First class parcel, air parcel post and perishable articles will be delivered six days.

2—Window service: Saturday window service will not exceed four hours. Only one consolidated stamp and parcel post window will be opened on Saturday. Window will be open 8:30, close 12:30. All registry and C.O.D. will be available at the consolidated window.

3—Miscellaneous Changes: Domestic and International money orders will not be issued on Saturday. Rural carriers will not accept money orders on Saturday. Meter settings, trust fund deposits, and box rent collections will be closed on Saturday.

The postmaster emphasized no essential major services are affected under this order. There will be no change in home delivery or special delivery, for example. Regular business mail de-

liveries will continue as usual. Letters and other first class mail will be handled with the same priority as ever. The economy step Mr. Chestnut explained, is in line with President Johnson's program.
