market value and that he thought it only fair that the valuations be reduced.

The Commissioners informed Mr. Hall that the property in question had been investigated and that it was in line with similar property and, further, that they, as a board of equalization and review, had adjourned permanently for the year and for that reason no action could be taken.

However, Mr. Hall maintained that the valuations were too high and that he has been losing money. He said he was willing to pay current taxes, providing the Commissioners would lower the valuation and refund him the excess taxes.

The Commissioners refused to take any action in the matter, so that Mr. Hall advised them that his only recourse was to bring suit in Superior Court. He said he had been advised by his attorney that he was entitled to relief and that he felt sure the court would uphold his request.
