

Little Theater Program Is Hit

"An Evening of Prose and Poetry" by Edenton Little Theater proved to be a real tonic for the frigid winter weather. To say it was well received would be a gross understatement.

The sets were simple. The lighting was adequate. The cast was small. So was the audience. But the content of the program was varied and exciting and the presentation by the readers was a sheer masterpiece.

Tone for the program was set by narrator Rex, Cliff Sheaf. He sat in his armchair at the left side of the St. Paul's Episcopal Church Parish House and introduced each selection as if he was telling his children a bedtime story.

The readers, Ross and Frances Inglis, Jimmy Ricks, Jane Holmes, Sheila Leary and Dick Lannon provided the voices for such works as "Brutus' Oration" from Julius Caesar, "Epigram" by Christopher Marlowe, Robert Frost's "The Road Not Taken," "Death Be Not Proud" by John Donne and Alfred Lord Tennyson's "The Charge of the Light Brigade."

One of the most thrilling readings was Sheila Leary and Ross Inglis in the murder scene from "Othello" by William Shakespeare. When they had finished their reading, which was complimented by their English accent, the audience of some 60 people patted momentarily before giving them a well deserved applause. It was a sign that the readers had completely captured the mood of the scene and carried the audience along with them.

Mrs. Elaine Williams directed the unusual presentation, a first for the local group. Jasper Hassell was in charge of lighting while Mrs. Angie Wright served tea and cookies during intermission.

The Edenton Little Theater, a rapidly expanding organization, has been highly successful in the two public presentations. If "An Evening of Prose and Poetry" is a fair example of the talent hereabouts, the public should call for more of the same.

DR. PHILIP A. TUMULTY Area Physicians To Hear Lecture

CHAPEL HILL—Patients with fevers of undetermined origin and patients with Cocksackie viral infections will be the concern of Eastern North Carolina and Virginia physicians at a 19-county medical meeting in Edenton next Wednesday.

Dr. Philip A. Tumulty of Baltimore, Md., professor of medicine at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and chairman of the private patient service at Johns Hopkins Hospital, will be the speaker for the fifth of a six-session postgraduate course in medicine.

The course is sponsored by the First District Medical Society, the University of North Carolina School of Medicine and the UNC Extension Division.

Participating physicians are from Bertie, Beaufort, Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Gates, Hertford, Hyde, Martin, Northampton, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Tyrrell and Washington counties in North Carolina and from the Tri-County Medical Society in Suffolk, Va., and the Princess Anne County Medical Society in Norfolk.

Dr. Tumulty will speak twice, at 4:30 P. M., on the treatment of patients with fever of undetermined origin and at 7:30 P. M. on Cocksackie viral infections and how they mimic serious diseases. Cocksackie disease is an infectious disease with many of the symptoms of infantile paralysis or spinal meningitis, but which usually clears up within a few days without after effects.
