Rissho Kosei Kai, one of the biggest of Japan's "new religions" has dedicated a new temple in Tokyo for the use of its 2.5 million members. The seven-story structure, largest building for religious use in the Orient, has 20,000 visitors a day and car. accommodate 30,000 persons. The beliefs of this "religion" center on Buddhist doctrines as interpreted by the 13th century Jauanese teacher Nichiren Shonin.


