Not long ago a New Jersey clergyman who visited Moscow passed along the information that the hottest black market item in the USSR today is the BIBLE.

Rissho Kosei Kai, one of the biggest of Japan's "new religions" has dedicated a new temple in Tokyo for the use of its 2.5 million members. The seven-story structure, largest building for religious use in the Orient, has 20,000 visitors a day and can accommodate 30,000 persons.

The beliefs of this "religion" center on Buddhist doctrines as interpreted by the 13th century Japanese teacher Nichiren Shonin.

At the same time this is happening, copies of the Bible and the sutra have been exchanged by the Japan Bible Society and All Japan Buddhist Association. In addition to the special presentation copies, about 2,000 Bibles donated by the Danish Bible Society were given to the Japan Bible Society for distribution to Buddhist priests throughout Japan.
