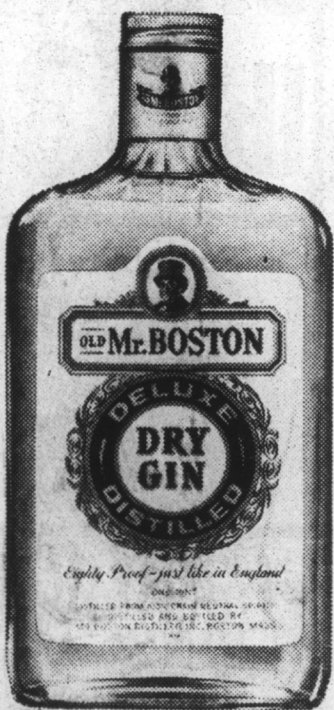

For in those by-gone days when toy making was not the precision industry it is today, we kids learned to make most of our own toys, especially toys of this kind, which in most cases were better than we could buy. Boyhood imagination invested all of these things with a reality that gave a greater dimension to make-believe than kids enjoy today. Today's toys are but scaled down replicas of the genuine article, precision built and realistically operational. And in playing with them, the kids of today are missing that vital something that imagination clothes things you make with your own hands and skill.

BUILDING PERMITS

Required After July 1, 1965

★
"Requiring a building permit in Chowan County" (Requires purchase of \$2.00 county builder's permit (proceeds to county general fund) from county accountant before erecting, remodeling or improving buildings at cost of more than \$500. Requires same permit without regard to value for installation or connection of house-trailers for living purposes. Holders of similar municipal permits not required to obtain county permit. Municipalities in county to file list of permits they have issued with county accountant. Violations of act made misdemeanors punishable by fine up to \$50 and imprisonment up to 30 days.)

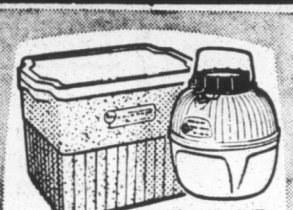
