

Tribute Is Paid Mrs. E. S. Burke

Mrs. Edmund S. Burke, Sr., 48, a member of a prominent Mount Airy family, died Thanksgiving Day at Northern Surry Hospital following an illness of several weeks.

A native of Edenton, Mrs. Burke was a daughter of Mrs. Effie M. Smith, 07 Pembroke Circle, and the sister of Mrs. Jean J'Neal.

The following is an editorial that appeared in the Mount Airy Times:

"There sometimes comes upon the scene—usually all too fleetingly—a person of such warmth of personality, graciousness, strength of character and ability to do things done that it seems the individual has always been in our midst. "Such a person was Mrs. Edmund S. Burke, Sr. "Then, for an inexplicable reason, she is suddenly no longer with us. The Almighty acting with His own wisdom and judgment, sees fit to remove her from the world of the living, taking her from this land to His own kingdom for His won service.

"Such, too, was the case with Mrs. Burke, who died Thanksgiving Day in Northern Surry Hospital after an illness of several weeks.

"While her life was centered about her husband and family, she yet realized that each individual has duties outside the family circle. And she filled those responsibilities well.

"President of the First Presbyterian's Women of the Church on several occasions, she had filled very nearly all of the organization's committee chairmanships during her service to her church and had also been chairman of various circles in the church. In addition, she was active in the work of the Winston-Salem Presbytery.

"Selfless with her time and talents, she was always willing to lend assistance to any project of the Women of the Church. It could easily be said that she was an example of that old axiom that, in order to get something done, ask a busy person to do it.

"Mrs. Burke was prominent in the Granite City's social life. She was a charter member of the Mount Airy Cotillion Club, and a member of the local Country Club and Wednesday Afternoon Book Club.

"Her friends, and they were numbered in the hundreds, will not forget the kind, thoughtful, energetic person that was Mrs. Meade Smith Burke."

Billings Returns To Area Monday

Bill Billings, football coach of Middletown, (Del.) High School, is scheduled as guest speaker at the annual Elizabeth City Rotary Club luncheon honoring the ECHS Yellow Jackets. The event is set for Monday at Circle Restaurant.

Billings coached the Aces of John A. Holmes High School from 1954 through 1961, rolling up an enviable record.

In Middletown he found a school whose grid squads had never won more than three conference games a season. He soon became the premier coach in the state as he put together one successful season after another.

With Billings at the helm, Middletown went undefeated for five years and the majority of a sixth. During that time (1962-67) his teams won 53 straight games, usually slaughtering their opposition.

Billings took on teams in bigger conferences and won. This year, however, the string ran out and his teams lost the last two games, both to schools with enrollments as much as three times that of Middletown.

His Delaware record, over a six year span, is 53-2.

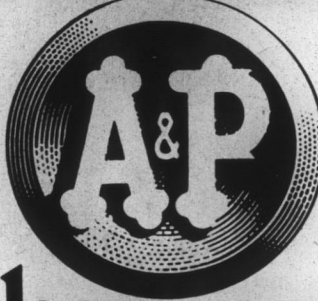
