Q—I am the widow of a World War I veteran. I understand that I may be entitled to a higher pension because I am in need of help to get around the house. Is this true? What must I do to get this increased pension?

A—A provision of the Veterans' Pension and Readjustment Assistance Act of 1967, which went into effect October 1, says that "if any widow is entitled to pension . . . and is in need of regular aid and attendance, the monthly rate of pension payable to her shall be increased by \$50." To obtain this pension you should call or write the Veterans Administration office nearest you. It would tendance.

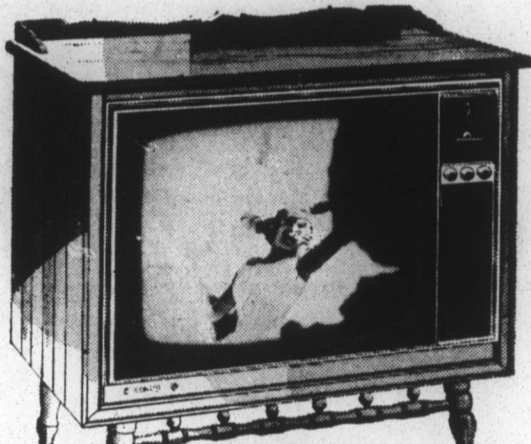

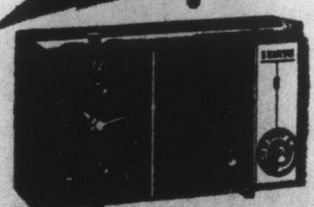
