Adding Beauty Plus Protection

Protection and privacy, two basic reasons for building a fence, now are often joined by a third consideration—beauty.

Traditional types of fencing such as steel chain links continue to serve their purpose of enclosing and protecting a property, but they add another dimension when they are planned as a backdrop for roses or other bushes and vines.

Lumber, one of the earliest fence materials, goes contemporary in attractive designs — louvers, wood, "bricks," parquet, herringbone, basketweave and lattice-work patterns.

Man-made materials such as fiberglass-plastic create unusual patterns in combination with wood framing. Panels of fiberglass-plastic provide privacy without cutting off light, thus serving many special needs.

Hardwood panels, used as fencing, can match or contrast with the siding of the home, and can be painted for decorative outdoor living room effects.

This Is The Law

POUR-OVER TRUST

Sam Scott delivered \$1,000,000 to the Integrity Trust Company under a trust instrument dated January 10, 1960. The X College was made the beneficiary of the trust. There was also a provision in the trust instrument reserving to Sam Scott a power of amendment.

On August 5, 1963, Ben Bogert executed a will in which he bequeathed \$500,000 to the Integrity Trust Company to be held as trustee "under the terms of a trust instrument dated January 10, 1960, executed by Sam Scott, and deposited with the Integrity Trust Company."

On April 1, 1965, Scott delivered to the Integrity Trust Company a written instrument amending the terms of the trust. Under the provisions of this amendment the Y College is made the beneficiary of the trust.

Bogert died on March 10, 1967. Which college is entitled to the income from the \$1,500,000?

Under a statute passed in 1955 by the General Assembly of North Carolina, the Y College would be the beneficiary of the \$1,500,000 trust fund.

Unless the will provides otherwise, the bequest of the \$500,000 operates to dispose of property under the terms of the trust as they appear in writing at the time of the testator's death. The North Carolina statute stipulates that the property bequeathed to the trustee of the existing trust

HIGHWAY SAFETY

Extensive tests have shown that damage to a car, after collision, is minimal and the driver remains unhurt and in control of the automobile. The first major installation of such safety poles has been made by the Minnesota State Highway Department.

shall not be deemed held under a testamentary trust.

The new law is not limited in its application to colleges. In fact, colleges are not even mentioned.

The North Carolina statute simply permits a testator to add to the funds of a trust created in writing prior to his death. The existing trust may be one that either he or another has setup. The fact that the existing trust is amendable or revocable is immaterial. The trust may be actually amended after the execution of the will, and the amendment need not be in the manner required by the law of wills.

May a person create a trust with himself as trustee and reserving to himself the income for life and the power to revoke or amend the trust?

Yes. The Supreme Court of North Carolina has held that a person may manifest in writing an intention to create a trust with himself as trustee, retaining the power to sell any part of the subject matter of the trust for his own benefit during his lifetime, with a further provision that the assets remaining in the trust at the time of the creator's death shall pass to named beneficiaries.

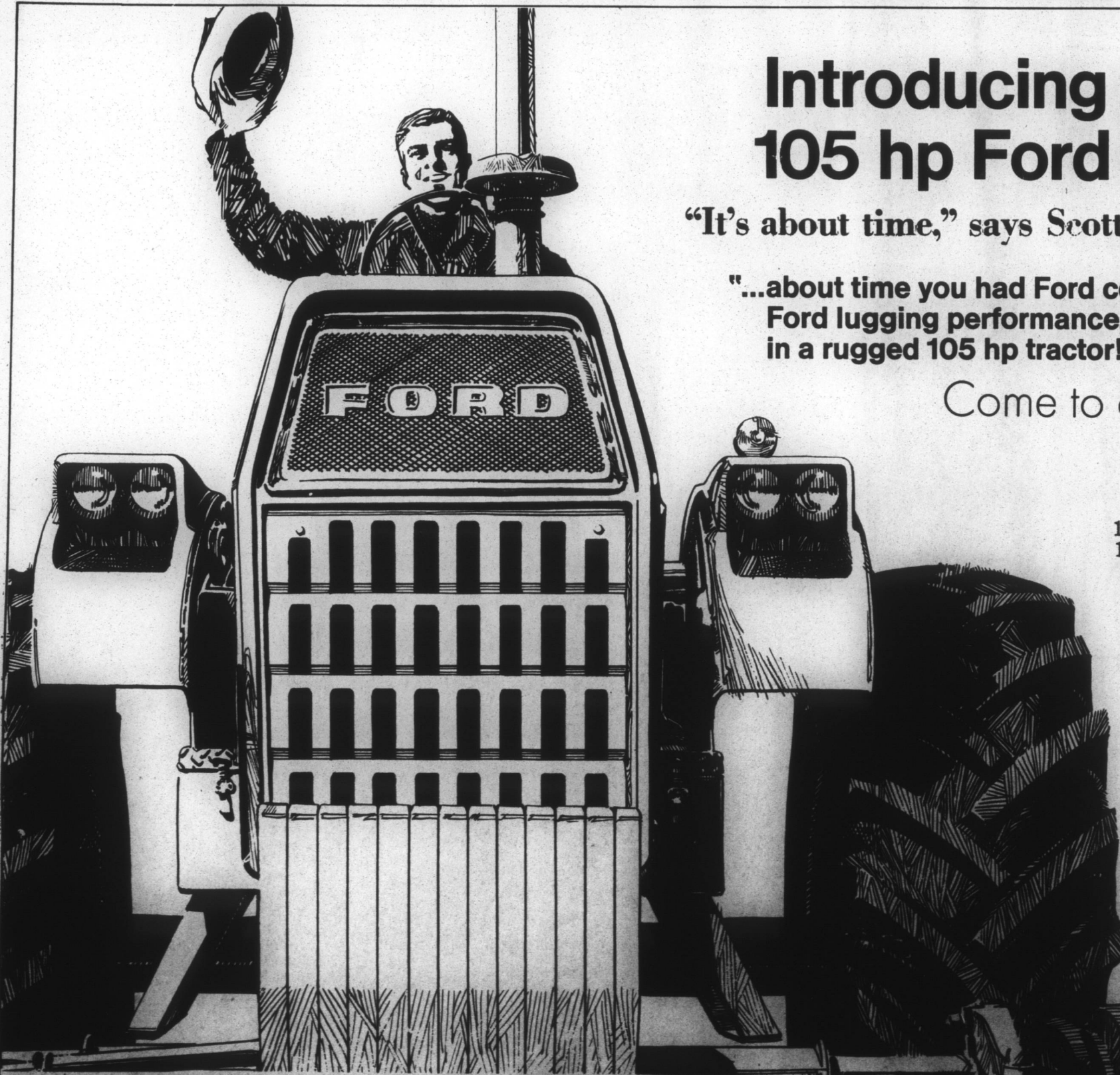
