Also, potash and nitrogen are the salts that often damage young seedlings when applied too heavily too closely. It is recommended that the amount of nitrogen and potash "actual" not be banded or placed over the crop at more than 80 pounds per acre to avoid injury. For example, 500 pounds of 510-10 fertilizer contains 50 pounds of potash and 25 pounds of nitrogen, making a total of 75 pounds of

> In the case of manganese, only about 50 to 60 pounds of 27 per cent manganese sulfate is needed per acre to bring the level up sufficiently for a period of three to five years perhaps. This is a difficult amount to apply individually but the grower can get it mixed with his fertilizer, as I am rec-
