1968 Certification

Again this year—1968—Chowan County farmers will have the responsibility of reporting their crop acreages to the ASCS office. This is what we call certification.

This system has worked extremely well. It is convenient for the farmer and also has resulted in a substantial savings in the operation of ASCS programs.

County offices give farmers as much assistance as possible to help assure that the acreages reported are correct. Farmers are furnished photocopies of their farms which give the acreages in each field. ASCS personnel will also assist farmers in making computations from measurements the farmers have made.

Farmers may also obtain official measurement services from ASCS. This service must be requested and paid for by the farmer. Two types of measurement services are available. Premeasurement, which has been available over the years, is still available. In addition, a farmer may get his acreage measured after planting is completed but before he certifies.

Agricultural Conservation Program

Requests are being accepted in the county office for federal cost-share assistance to help farmers carry out a needed conservation practice. Look over your needs and make an application before the practice is started.

Below is a list of some of the practices available and the cost-share rates:

A-2 permanent pasture, up to \$23.44 per acre.
B-7 farm ponds, .08 cubic yard.

C-9 open ditch drainage, 10 cubic yard.

C-10 tile drainage, .18 lineal foot.

D-1 winter cover crop, \$2.00 per acre.

If your farm would benefit from the use of one of these practices, file your written request now.

Reminders

Diverted acreage cannot be grazed between April 30 and October 1, 1968.

Final date to lease and transfer peanut acreage is May 11, 1968.

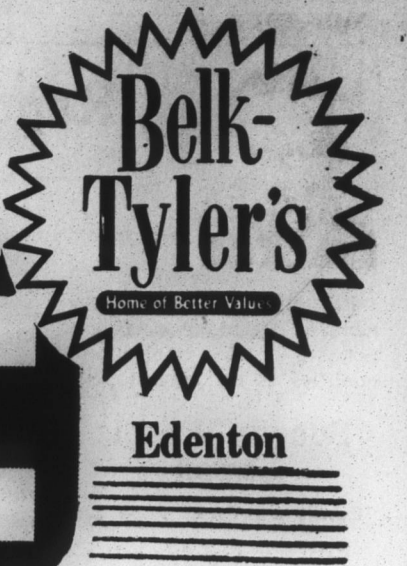

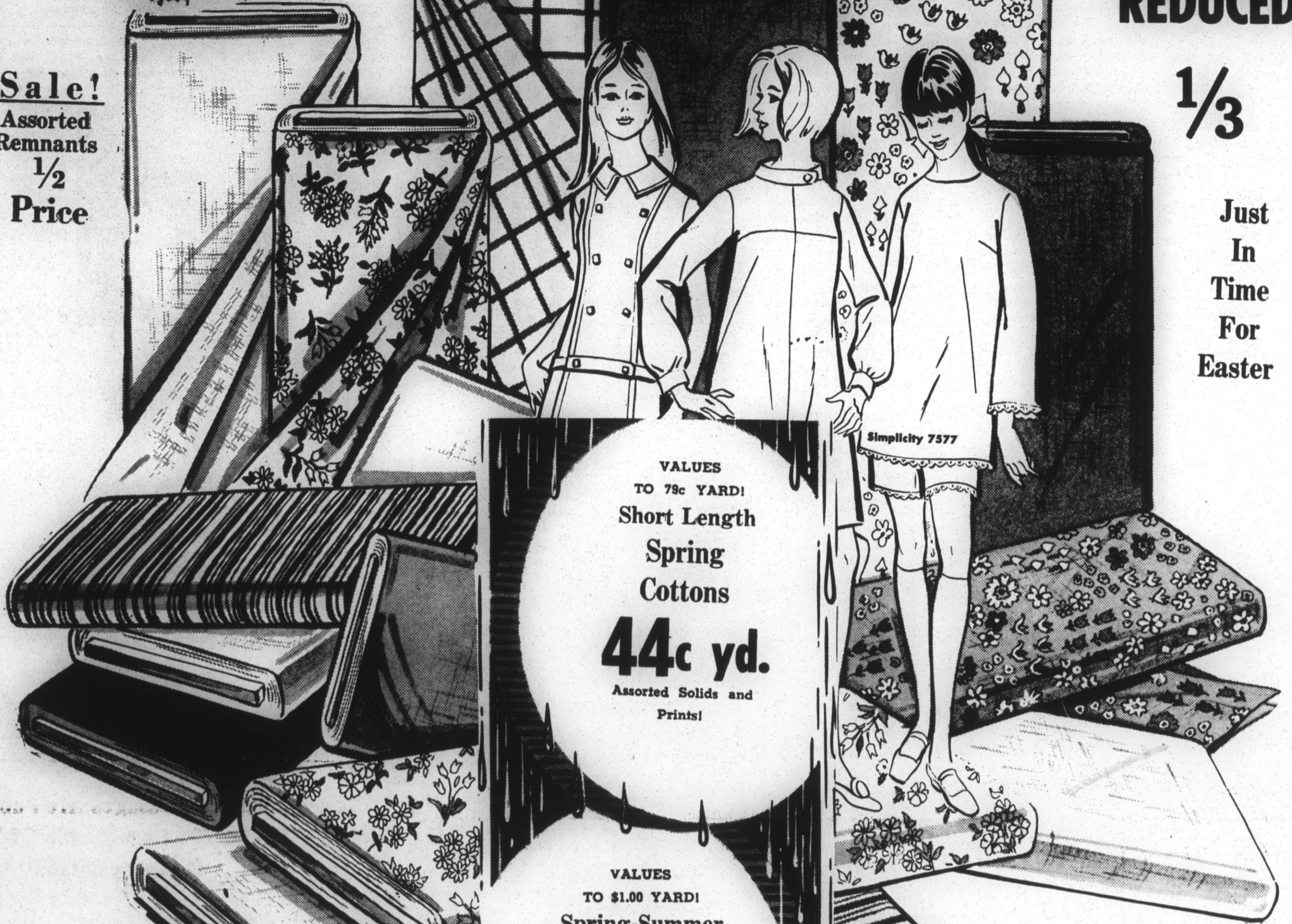
