

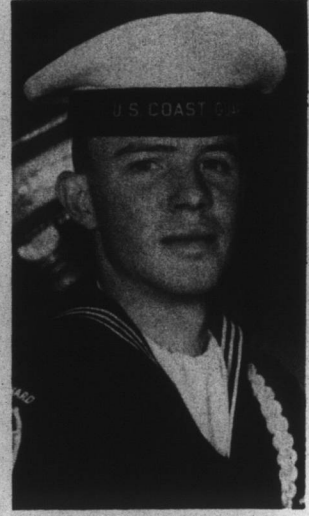
Plans Are Made For Workshop
