



**Know Your Social Security**

Frank Kirkland, Field Representative of the Social Security Administration, is in Edenton every Thursday and is located in the Court House.

I wish social security taxes would stop going up! We hear this comment often at the social security office. Actually, the tax rate this year is the same as it was in 1967. Some people will pay more in social security taxes this year, however, because more of their earnings are covered—up to \$7,800 as compared to \$6,600 last year.

Your next question might be, "Why do we pay taxes on higher earnings?" The social security system is based on an insurance principle. The idea behind social security is to replace earnings lost or reduced because the worker either retires, becomes disabled or dies. You've heard the old saying, "You only get out of it what you have put in it." Well, social security works somewhat the same way. The more a person pays on higher earnings,

the more he gets when he retires or becomes disabled or the more his dependents will get if he dies.

When social security first began in 1937, only \$3,000 of a worker's earnings were covered. However, in those days, this meant about 95 per cent of working people had all their earnings covered for social security. All wages increased, the percentage of people with all their earnings covered by social security decreased. Even though the amount of annual earnings covered by social security has increased and is now \$7,800 per year, only 84 per cent of the workers have all their earnings covered for social security. Before 1950, the most a worker could get from social security was \$85 per month, and the most his family could receive was \$200 per month. Under the present law, it is possible for a young worker to qualify for \$218 a month, and his total family benefits to be as much as \$434.40.

The basic idea in social security is that persons who work pay into trust funds. When these people have a loss of income due to old age, disability, death or medical expenses after 65—the trust funds pay off. The pay off is based on the average yearly earnings of the insured person who paid the taxes in the trust funds. The higher the earnings, the higher the protection of a young worker and his family.

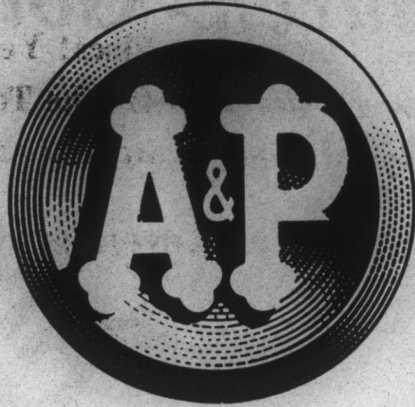

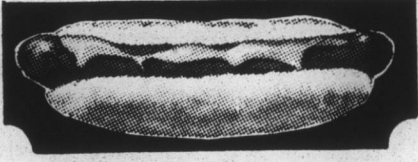

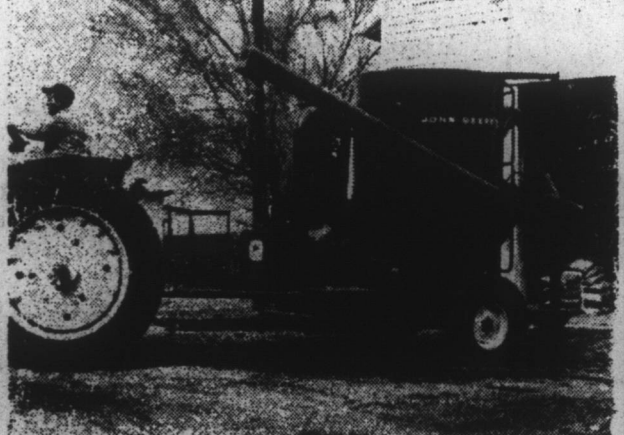
