LETTER TO THE EDITOR

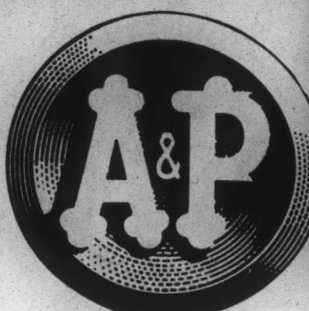
Dear Editor:
