On S. S. Reports

Although most employers know how to report wages for social security, some are still not sure of the special rules that apply to domestic workers.

A worker must show his social security card to his employer when he or she starts to work. The employer reports the name, the number and wages to Internal Revenue Service at the end of the calendar quarter in which the wages are paid. He also sends a check covering the tax contribution along with his report. The reports and contributions are due for all household workers who are paid \$50 or more in cash by one employer during the calendar quar-
