Coston "Profile" Given In December Magazine

John D. Coston, general manager of Albemarle Electric Membership Corporation in Hertford, will be featured as personality of the month in the December issue of "The Carolina Farmer."

The magazine, which has approximately 200,000 subscribers across the state, will salute Coston in a "Profile" for his leadership in rural development and community activities.

Albemarle EMC serves nearly 4,000 member-owners in sections of Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Pasquotank and Perquimans counties. Most of its members farm large acreage grain crops, but many work as far away as Norfolk and Plymouth.

Coston, who has served

as manager of the electric cooperative for 18 years, is cited in the story for his outstanding record in civic and community activities.

The article says "his record shows that he has always worked for the good of the people in the area" and that "he has been a success."

Coston has served on the board of directors of the Chamber of Commerce, the Winfall Water Board, the Industrial Development Corporation and the Albemarle Area Development Association of which he was also vice president.

"While at Albemarle," the article says, "Coston has made the co-op a true community builder. In the nearby community of Winfall . . . the co-op encouraged and worked with the people to help develop a community water system . . . assisted in organizing and financing the Albemarle Area Development Association . . . helped to launch and finance the Albemarle Planning Commission."

Coston, a native of Hookerton, is married to the former Grace Mattock of Maysville. They attend the Hertford Methodist Church.

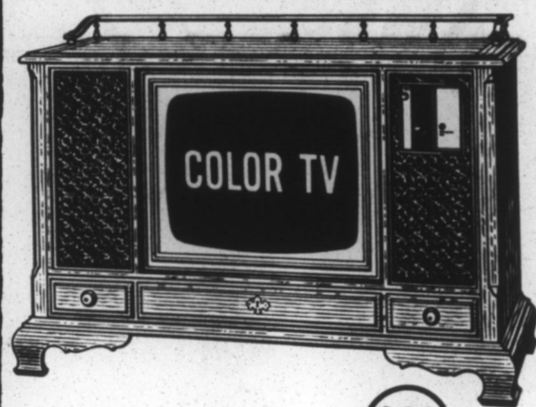

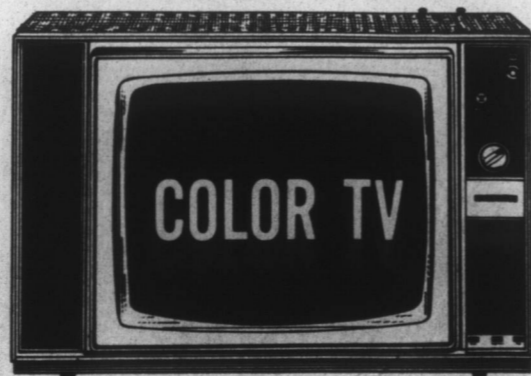

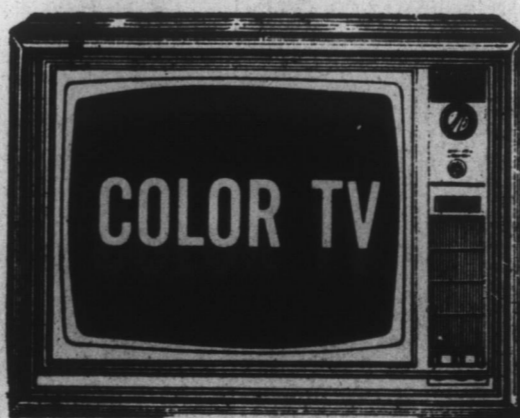
