Actually, the amendment which I intend to offer seeks to utilize the judgments of the senior judges of our country on a matter of grave importance — the fate of constitutional government in our land. The President frequently calls upon advisory commissions for advice. In this instance, a mandatory requirement that he obtain the opinion of the Chief Justice of our State Courts and the senior Judge of the U.S. Circuit Courts of Appeals would give stature to the nominating process that is coming under increasing question. It would also preserve the essence of our federal system in the pro-

For these reasons, I plan to reoffer my amendment requiring such a method of selecting Justices of our Supreme Court.




