

Hertford Plant Forms Brigade

Don Juan Manufacturing Company of Hertford has formed an Industrial Fire Brigade for in-plant protection. This fire brigade is now completing a special 15-hour training course.

Charles K. Shneer, Don Juan manager, and also chief of the brigade, stated, "This training is something we have wanted for a long time."

The fire protection personnel are receiving training in basic firemanship, fire and hazardous material classification, use of portable fire extinguishers, automatic sprinkler systems, basic first aid and rescue methods, emergency plant evacuation procedures, fire prevention inspections and job safety methods.

This training is being conducted by Charles Skinner, Jr., of the Hertford Fire Department. Skinner is a fire and safety instructor with the Department of Community Colleges. He is working through the College of the Albemarle Adult Training Division.

Skinner said, "These fire brigades at Don Juan have shown a great deal of interest in this training and will be in the position to render valuable service to their company and community in the time of emergencies."

Services include transportation, dressings, drugs, nursing, loan closet and housekeeping.

Mrs. Kenneth Floars, service chairman, reported that in the first 10 months of 1968 there were 11 applications for service. People in need of any of the services should contact Mrs. Floars for additional information.

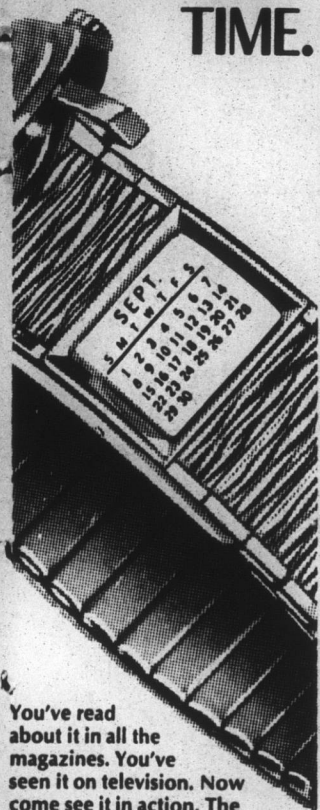

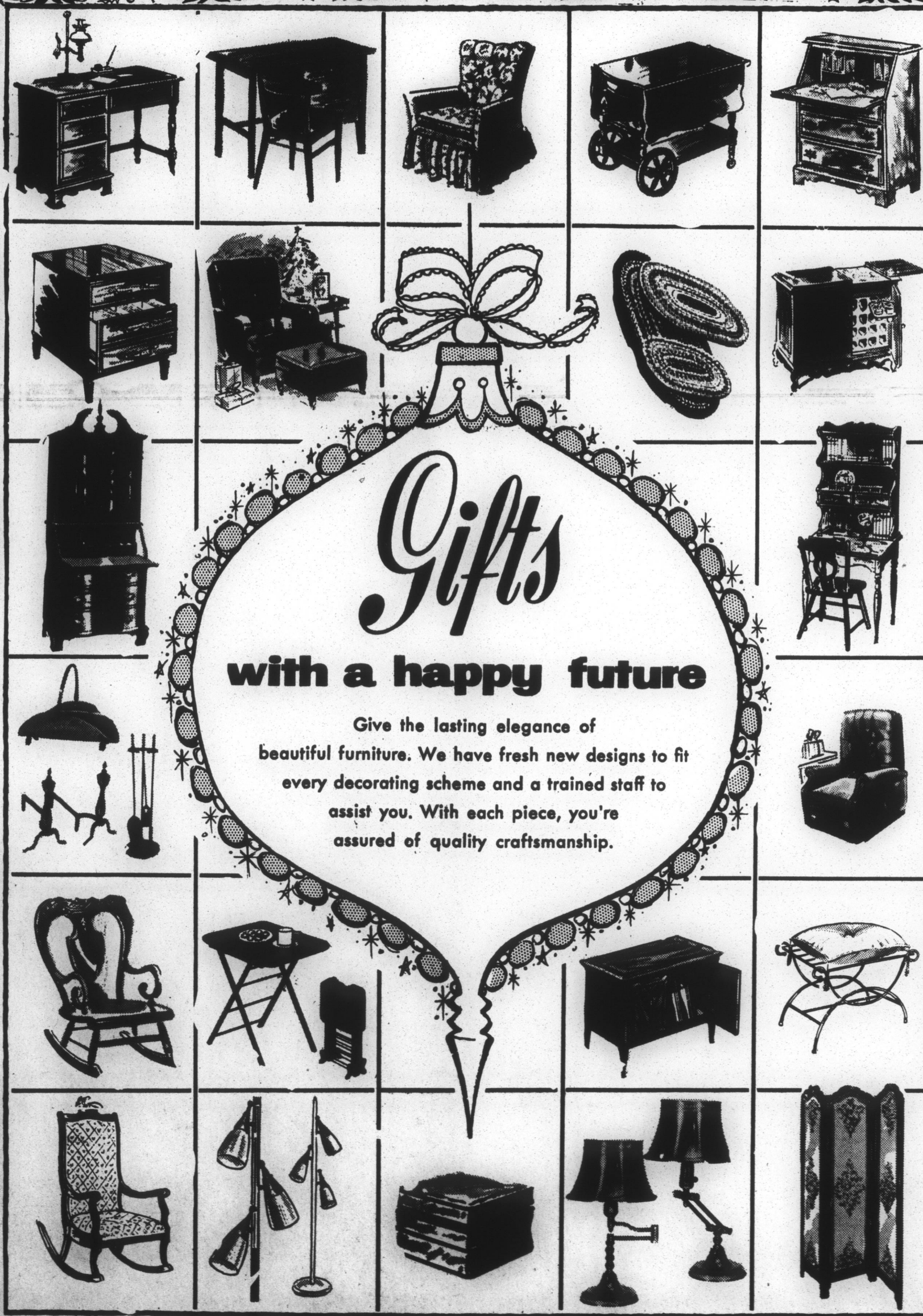
