3 tablespoons butter.
1½ cups sugar.
3 squares of bitter chocolate (melted).

Beat eggs until light, add other ingredients, then cook in sauce pan on high heat until mixture boils, stirring continuously. Remove from heat, then beat until cold and thick enough to spread.

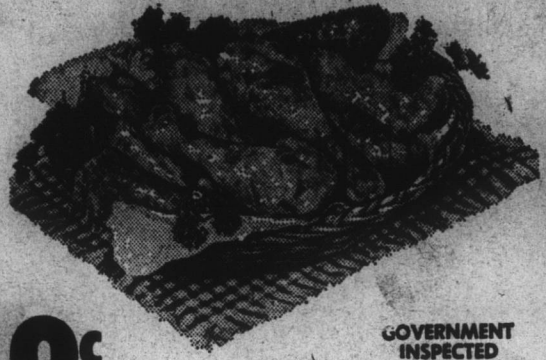
