Airman Nixon, a munitions specialist, was selected for his exemplary conduct and duty performance. He is assigned to a unit of the Pacific Air Forces.

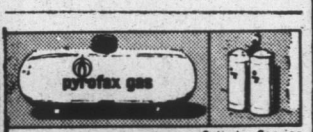
The airman is a graduate of Chowan High School at Tyner, N. C.

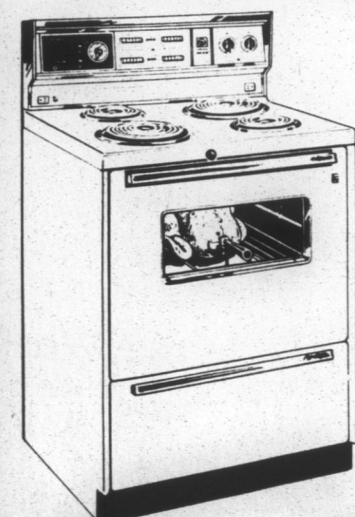

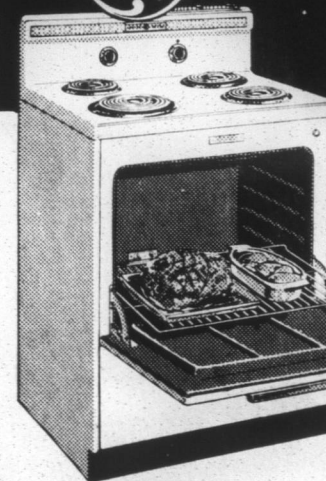
