A buffet luncheon was served to the 54 members attending.

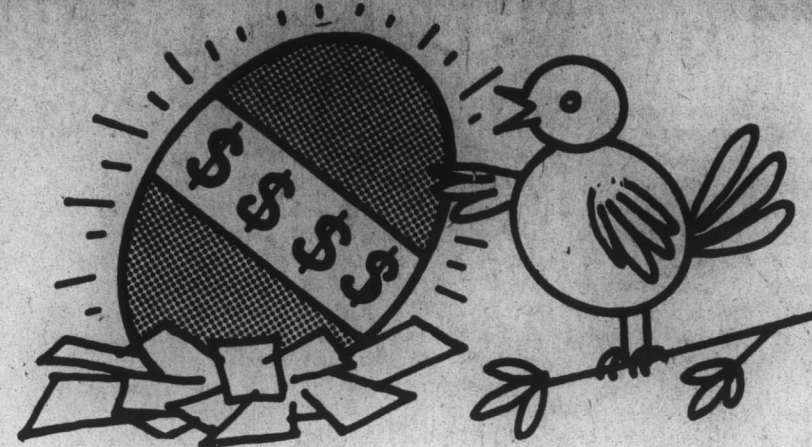
