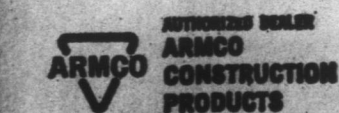

Edenton has won recognition in the newest edition of the country's best selling national tourist guidebook, the 1969 Mobil Travel Guide.

Out of all the cities and towns in the U. S., only 4,208 were considered to have enough tourist-appeal for inclusion in the guides. Our town is one of them.

In addition to giving information on where to go, the books list over 23,000 places to eat and sleep with each one rated on a one to five star basis. One star indicates "good, better than average." Five means "one of the best in the country." Only 35 establishments have five star status in the new edition.

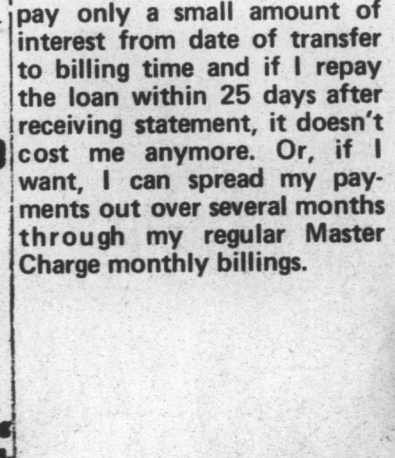

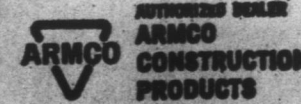
