

Adult Driving Course Is Planned By College

The Continuing Education Division of College of The Albemarle will offer a drivers education program in Chowan County if sufficient interest is shown. The driving program will be the same type 54-hour course that is presently offered by the public school system, consisting of six hours of driving, 12 hours of observation and 36 hours of classroom work. Certificates will be issued to those successfully completing the driving and classroom phase of instruction.

The class will be limited to adults, 18 years of age and older, and the maximum number of students in the first class will be 21 students.

A fee of \$16 will be charged for each student and must be paid no later than the first night of class.

The classroom instruction will be held on Tuesday and Thursday nights from 7 P. M., to 10 P. M., for six weeks. Actual driving instruction will be held late in the afternoon or on Saturday. Students will be assigned to the driving phase by instructors.

Postal Increase Being Pushed

An "inherited" postal deficit of \$1.2 billion is responsible for the proposals to raise the postage bill for residents of Edenton, Postmaster James Bond has said.

Bond said he had been advised by Postmaster General Winton M. Blount in Washington, D. C., that the record \$1.2 billion 1970 deficit compelled President Nixon to seek postage rate increases. Without higher rates the Department will be left with a staggering deficit that would become an added public tax burden.

In addition to increasing letter main from six to seven cents, as proposed by the Johnson Administration, President Nixon also asked that second and third-class mailers help reduce the large postal deficit which would otherwise be paid by taxpayers, the postmaster said.

For bulk third-class mail and most magazines and newspapers, the rates would be increased 16 percent to 20 percent above today's levels, he noted. These percentages include rate hikes already scheduled by previous action of Congress.

The President's recommended increases will reduce the 1970 postal deficit by more than \$600 million.
