purpose of amending the Constitution upon application of two-third

expressed fears about such a convention. In my judg-
ment, most ment, most of these con-
cerns arise out of fear that a convention might seek to rewrite the entire Const
tution. Recognizing this, and also the duty of Congress to deal with the problem under the presen circumstances, my bill e
tablishes the framework such a convention and
deals with the procedural complexities that have never before been dealt with
