Continued from Page 3 and spices; add. Mix lightly. Stir in walnuts, apples and raisins. Mix well. Drop by spoonfuls on greased baking sheets. Bake at 350 degrees for 12 to 15 minutes. Makes about six dozen cookies.

We had a real good pork roast the other twilight which is a sure sign the weather is getting cooler—at night, anyway.

All of the new magazines arriving at our house are featuring pork in the food sections. Family Circle gives this recipe for Barbecued Pork Roll.

Barbecued Pork Roll
1 rolled boned center-cut loin of pork, about 6 lbs.
1 cup chili sauce.
1 large onion, diced.
3/4 cup maple-blended syrup.

1 teaspoon mixed salad herbs.
1 teaspoon pumpkin-pie spice.

Place pork on rack in a shallow roasting pan. Insert meat thermometer into roast so bulb reaches the center. Roast in 325 degree oven for one and one-half hours. Combine chili sauce, onion, syrup, salad herbs and pumpkin-pie spice in a small saucepan; heat to boiling. Spoon part over roast to coat generously. Continue roasting, spooning more sauce over meat every 15 minutes, one hour, or until thermometer registers 170 degrees. Remove roast to a heated serving platter. Garnish with baked tomato cups stuffed with buttered green beans or peas, and chicory or curly endive, if you wish.

O. Blanchard farm situate in Third Township, Chowan County, N. C., and more particularly set forth on an attachment to and made part of this Notice of Sale of Timber.

All timber which is to be cut and removed from the lands described shall be cut and removed therefrom on or before two years next after the date of the deed; and all timber not cut and removed from said land on or before said date shall be the property of the then owner or owners of said lands.

The purchaser shall have the right to remove from said land all of the limbs, tops and slabs of the timber cut by said purchaser provided the same are removed from said land on or before two years next after the date of the deed. In cutting and removing said timber from the above described lands, the purchaser shall have the right to cut or injure such smaller timber as is reasonably necessary to handle and remove the timber which the purchaser is allowed to cut under the timber deed, but shall take all reasonable precautions that no smaller timber be cut or injured other than such as is reasonably necessary.
