1/2 tsp. baking powder.
2 tsp. soda.
1 1/2 tsp. salt.
1 tsp. cinnamon,
1/2 tsp. cloves.
2/3 cup nuts.
2/3 cup chopped dates.
2 2/3 cups sugar.
2/3 cup salad oil.
4 eggs.
2 cups pumpkin.
2/3 cup water.
Sift flour, measure, then add baking powder, soda, salt and spices. Toss nuts and fruit lightly in flour mixture. Beat sugar and oil in mixer at slow speed. Add eggs, one at a time; add pumpkin, then add flour mixture and water and beat thoroughly. Pour into two greased loaf pans and bake for one hour in 350 degree oven.

My sister-in-law from Keedysville, Md., sends me her recipe for making homemade apple butter on a small scale. She says it is delicious:

16 cups apple sauce.
3 pounds brown sugar.
1 1/2 cups apple cider.
Stir several times. Put in large roaster and cook in a slow oven. In about 3 1/2 hours it is done. (Without mess or splatter).

A Few Hints
Cellophane tabs over the labels of medicine bottle will keep the name, directions and prescription number unspotted.

Perspiration stains on washables can be erased if covered with a baking soda paste for a few minutes before laundering.

Save the water in which potatoes were boiled and use it for about an hour. Wash and dry the usual way and you'll be amazed at how well it looks.

Spilled coffee can be cleaned from a rug by blotting up the excess, then rubbing the spot with a solution of vinegar, detergent and water.

People try not to steam up a bathroom, but it comes in handy when the walls have to be cleaned. Just steam the room intentionally and go over the walls and ceiling with a dry cloth.

cup peppermint stick candy crushed and a dash of red food coloring. Top each cookie with a teaspoon of meringue. Bake at 325 degrees for 15 to 18 minutes. Makes 45 cookies.

Cheesecake Cookies

1/2 stick butter.
1/3 cup firmly packed light brown sugar.
1 cup flour.
1/2 cup chopped pecans.
1/2 cup currant jelly.
1 pkg. (8 oz.) cream cheese.
1/4 cup sugar.
1 egg.
2 tablespoons milk.
2 tablespoons lemon juice.

1/2 teaspoon vanilla.

In mixing bowl cream butter; add brown sugar and flour. Blend until mixture resembles cornmeal. Stir in pecans. Reserve one cup of mixture for topping. Press remainder onto bottom of eight-inch square baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees 15 minutes. Cool; spread jelly over crust. To prepare filling beat together cream cheese and sugar. Beat in egg and milk. Add lemon juice and vanilla. Turn into pan; sprinkle with reserved crumb mixture. Bake 30 minutes. Cool on wire rack; cut into bars or squares. Makes about 30 cookies.

Jewelled Thumbprints and Butter Rum Cheese Bars are gaily decorated holiday cookies that can be made by the short-cut method—refrigerated slice and bake cookie dough from the grocer's case.

1 roll Refrigerated Butterscotch Nut, Peanut Butter or Sugar Cookies.
1/4 cup butter, melted.
2 cups chopped pecans.
Red or green jelly.

Slice cookie dough into one-eighth inch thick slices. Roll each in a ball. Dip in butter; roll in chopped nuts. Place on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 375 degrees for 10 to 12 minutes until golden brown. (Cookies will be puffy when removed from the oven). Remove from the oven; indent the center of each warm cookie with thumb and place one-fourth teaspoon jelly in each center. Cool; loosen with spatula.

Butter Rum Cheese Bars

1 roll Refrigerated Slice 'N Bake Cookies.
1/2 cup sugar.
1 pkg. (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened.
1 egg.
1/2 to 1 teaspoon rum flavoring.

Slice cookie dough one-fourth inch thick; place in bottom of greased eight or nine-inch square pan. Bake at 375 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes until lightly browned. Cool slightly. In small mixer bowl cream sugar and cheese. Add egg and flavoring and beat until smooth. Pour cheese mixture over baked cookie base and return to 375 degree oven for 20 to 25 minutes. Cool slightly; refrigerate for at least one hour. Cut into 20 bars and decorate with nuts, candied fruits or decorator frosting.

Chesson Master Of Duke Tricks

DURHAM — Most fans were looking the other way and the movie cameras were turned off, so many of the sell-out crowd at Wallace Wade Stadium Saturday missed the beginning of the "sprint-killer" play which brought Duke a 17-13 upset victory over North Carolina.

What most people saw was Wes Chesson streaking down the sidelines on a 53-yard touchdown run. They missed the trick beginning which triggered the play while Carolina was still in its defensive huddle.

It came as no surprise, however, that the "master of surprises" was Chesson. Duke Coach Tom Harp remarked, "Chesson has made a few big plays, and he adjusts well to the unexpected. He'd run the fake punt and fake field goal before Saturday and was naturally the man to go to in this situation."

Chesson picked up 65 yards in three carries Saturday, bringing his season total to 119 net yards in 21 carries, a 5.7 average which led the Duke squad. He was also the team's fourth leading rusher in yards gained.

Chesson caught five passes for 24 yards Saturday, bringing his two-year

career total to 1,319 yards pass receiving. He also caught a six-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter, to knot the score 7-7.

Chesson, a jack-of-all-trades, had his best game punting, with a 40.8 yard average on eight punts.
