## Local Students Will View Scenes

RALEIGH—Productions of scenes from "Love's Labour's Lost" will be presented in two schools of the Edenton-Chowan unit in mid-March.

A production will be held in John A. Holmes High School Auditorium on March 18 and at Chowan High School on March 19.

The performances will be presented by Theater-In-Education, Inc., a professional New York dramatic company touring the state for the eighth successive year. The productions are made possible each year through funds provided the State Board of Education by the General Assembly.

The programs will include, in addition to scenes from "Love's Labour's Lost," a narrative text written by Marchette Chute to give continuity and clarity to the scenes. The length of the performance is one hour.

According to Raymond K. Rhodes, student activities consultant with the State Department of Public Instruction, the presentation of live Shakespeare drama in the public schools of North Carolina affords the state the unique opportunity of bringing students a dramatic awareness of the universal importance of Shakespeare.
