Farmers Subject To Income Tax

GREENSBORO-North Carolina farmers are subject to self-employment tax for 1969 if their farm income is \$400 or more, J. E. Wall, district director of the Internal Revenue Service, advised today. The self-employment tax

rate is 6.9 per cent with a maximum of \$538.20, and is in addition to income tax. A self-employed farmer is one who operates his own business or farm. A farmer is also considered self-employed if he employs others to operate or work his farm

even though he does not live on it himself. A farmer must file a federal income tax return and pay the self-employment tax tue if his net earnings from self-employment are \$400 or more, even if his gross income
