moon and other space probes that had landed on the moon. The narrator told us that Apollo 20 was going to take a space station into space and men would live in it for 28 days, then another space team will live in it for 138 days and then work up to a year. Mariner 4 and 5 took pictures of Mars. The pictures showed land that was white, red, brown and green.

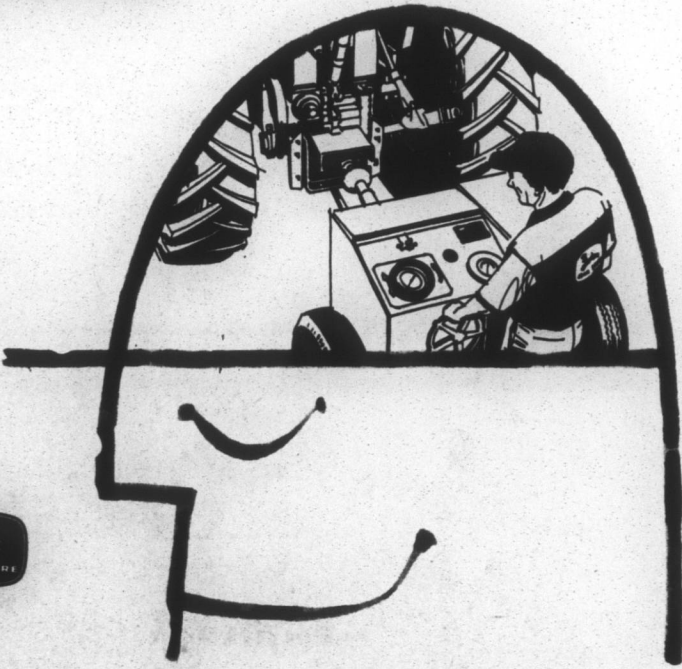
