Notice Of Intention To Apply To The Local Government Commission For Approval Of Bonds

NOTICE is hereby given of intention of the undersigned to file application with the Local Government Commission, Raleigh, N. C., for its approval of the issuance of the following proposed bonds of the Town of Edenton, which bonds shall be subject to approval of the voters of said Town at an election:

(1) \$375,000 of bonds to finance the extension, improvement and enlargement of the system maintained by the Town to provide a supply of water to said Town and

its inhabitants by the construction of water treatment facilities, facilities providing for an increased supply of water, water storage facilities and the extension of water lines, including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required therefor and the acquisition of the necessary lands or rights-in-land.

(2) \$225,000 of bonds to finance the extension, improvement, and enlargement of the sanitary sewer system maintained and operated by the Town for the collection and disposal of sewage by the extension of sewer lines, including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required therefor and the acquisition of the necessary lands or rights-in-land.

The notice was first published on the 19th day of February, 1970. Any citizen or taxpayer objecting to the issuance of any or all of said bonds may file with the Local Government Commission a verified statement setting forth his objections as provided in Section 159-7.1 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, in which event he shall also file a copy of such statement with the undersigned, at any time within ten days from and after such first publication. A copy of this notice must be attached to the statement so filed. Objections set forth in said statement shall be for consideration by said Commission in its determination of whether or not it may hold a public hearing as provided by law on the matter of the issuance of said bonds.
